Battalion UAS surveillance coverage extends from approximately 3 to 13 kilometers—between the limit of company UAS surveillance and the maximum range of 120-mm mortars.

Battalion scouts set a screen within a zone 3- to 13-km deep to support UAS coverage.

Combined arms companies deploy two to four abreast, depending on mission variables.

Unit positions provide mutual support to reinforce with fire and block infiltration, even in low visibility.

Battalion mortars are dispersed in a triangular pattern, approximately 100 meters between each position.

The battalion reserve consists of at least one platoon, positioned to rapidly reinforce vulnerable areas.
