UAS assets will be integrated with maneuver forces to conduct reconnaissance of enemy positions, identify opportunities for exploitation of enemy flanks, and provide continuous assessment of enemy counterattack potential.

The assault platoon advances to the objective, with the second platoon in a follow-and-support role.

The platoon(-) is augmented with antitank teams and automatic grenade launchers to provide support by fire.

Platoon-sized elements will maintain a separation of 250 to 500 meters, with vehicles maintaining internal spacing of 100 to 250 meters, adjusted for mission variables.

The reserve component consists of at least one squad.
