


## Division Attack on a Fortified Enemy

This template describes a Russian armed forces division in an attack on a fortified enemy as part of the first echelon of a combined arms army (CAA) or army corps.

When on offense, a division's first echelon typically consists of two or three motorized rifle or tank regiments.

The second echelon typically consists of a motorized rifle or tank regiment.

The CAR typically consists of a motorized rifle or tank battalion.

The antitank reserve typically consists of one antitank battalion.

The FSD typically consists of a motorized rifle battalion detached from a first echelon regiment, which usually advances 25 to 30 kilometers ahead of the main body.

The division's immediate objective is typically situated 10 to 15 kilometers (with a duration of 5 to 6 hours) in front of the line of contact.

The subsequent objective is located up to 15 kilometers (with a duration of 6 to 8 hours)

in front of the line of contact.

The DAG typically consists of the artillery in the artillery regiment (excluding antitank artillery), along with any assets allocated from the CAA's army artillery group, minus those artillery units that the division has assigned to subordinate units.
