This template describes a Russian Ground Forces brigade in a positional defense as part of the first echelon of a combined arms army (CAA) or army corps.

A brigade's total defensive width is approximately 10 to 15 kilometers, with a total depth of up to 25 kilometers.

The first echelon typically consists of two to four motorized rifle or tank battalions. Their task is to block, contain, or destroy probes; retain vital terrain or infrastructure; and canalize enemy efforts to destroy the attack.

The second echelon typically consists of one motorized rifle or tank battalion. Its task is to provide support by fire (SBF), contain or counter breakthroughs, and neutralize or destroy the attack.

The CAR usually includes one motorized rifle or tank battalion. Its task is to provide SBF, conduct counterattacks, and shape the defense to block or disrupt the attack or restore the defense.

The ATR typically consists of one antitank battalion. Its task is to destroy enemy armor, secure flanks, and interdict forces to secure the defense.

A brigade may detach companies from the first echelon battalions to conduct security operations in the security zone.

The BrAG typically consists of the artillery in the brigade's artillery battalions (excluding antitank artillery), along with assets allocated from the CAA's artillery group, minus those units the brigade has assigned to subordinate units. Its task is to suppress or neutralize artillery, support the counterattack by fire, and destroy formations to defeat or contain the attack.
